

# WHAT TO CHOSE & ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

### ACADEMIC OR VOCATIONAL. YOU HAVE SO MUCH CHOICE.

If you want to stay in full-time education, you can choose subjects that interest you, either a variety at A Level or specialising in one area on a vocational course. You may decide classroom-based learning isn't for you anymore. Many of our full-time Vocational courses are practically based, or vou could start an Apprenticeship. learning while at work and coming to College on specific days. We also offer programmes for those with no prior qualifications, who are seeking employment or access to full-time education.

All of these options will give you an advantage whether you want to find a job or go on to university. We'll help you make the choice that's right for you.

For more information about your options, make sure you attend one of our many Open Events. Whether online or in person, you will get the opportunity to see our fantastic facilities and find out about your life as a student at one of the best colleges in the country. For those with special educational needs and disabilities.



How long is it? Various durations.

What do you need? No prior qualification required.

What is it? These Entry Level and Level 1 courses are designed to enable students with learning difficulties and disabilities to obtain the skills they need to participate within the community. Many programmes are tailored to your individual needs and have a flexible approach.

Programmes that balance work experience and qualifications leading to Apprenticeships, further study or work. Work-based qualifications that enable you to get real life experience and earn while you learn. Specialist vocational courses. In order to reach Level 3 you must complete an appropriate lower level.

# PROGRESSION: PERSONAL PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT & TRAINEESHIPS LEVEL 1, 2, 3 & 4

How long is it? Various durations.

What do you need? No prior qualification required.

What is it? These programmes put an equal emphasis on qualifications and work experience leading to an Apprenticeship, Further Education or paid employment.

You will be able to develop your skills to ensure that you are ready and able to obtain a full-time job or an Apprenticeship. Alternatively, you may decide that after your work placement, further education is required to obtain your career aspirations; as a Truro and Penwith College student you will have access to all of the relevant courses that the College has to offer.

# APPRENTICESHIPS

**How long is it?** A minimum of 12 months.

What do you need? There are no formal requirements as Apprenticeships are not just based on previous academic achievement. Apprenticeships are available to anyone over the age of 16. Some start in September but many start throughout the year. You will need to be committed, motivated, enthusiastic and reliable. Applicants will typically be interviewed prior to starting an Apprenticeship programme.

What is it? As an Apprentice you will be working for a local business, earning a real wage, gaining practical skills and completing nationally recognised qualifications. Choosing the Apprenticeship route gets you straight into the career of your choice. After finishing, the majority of Apprentices (85%) will stay in employment, with twothirds (64%) staying with the same employer. You will be employed for at least 30 hours per week and take part in a mixture of taught courses, workshops, work-based assessments and e-learning. ## TECHNICAL COURSES Level 1, 2 & 3

**How long is it?** Various durations depending on subject and level.

### What do you need?

Hair, Beauty and Catering Level 1: Three GCSEs at Grade 2 including English Language (or English Literature) and/or Maths.

Hair, Beauty and Catering Level 2: Three GCSEs at Grade 3 plus either English Language (or English Literature) and/or Maths at Grade 4.

Construction Level 1: Two GCSEs at Grade 2 including English Language (or English Literature) and/or Maths.\*

Motor Vehicle Level 1: Three GCSEs at Grade 2 including English Language (or English Literature), Maths and a Science.\*

\* These grades are desirable but all will be considered following a successful interview.

Level 3 Technical courses require successful completion of a lowerlevel qualification in an appropriate subject.

What is it? Technical courses involve studying the theory and practical elements of your chosen subject. These will enable you to develop occupational knowledge and progress into industry.

A full-time vocational course in a single specific subject focused on progression to further study or employment.

A full-time vocational course in a single specific subject that is equivalent to three A Levels.

Equivalent to one A Level and studied as part of an A Level programme.

## PROGRESSION: AWARDS, CERTIFICATES & DIPLOMAS LEVEL 1 & 2

How long is it? One year.

What do you need? Level 1: No prior qualification required. Progression 2: You are required to achieve three GCSEs at Grade 3 including English Language (or English Literature) and/or Maths.

What is it? These courses are focused on progression, either to further study, an Apprenticeship or into employment. You will develop knowledge and understanding by applying your learning and skills in a work-related context.

Level 1 pathways include Functional Skills English and Maths up to Level 1 and a Work Skills qualification. Achievement at Level 1 is essential for progression onto Level 2 courses. The Level 2 pathway encompasses specific vocational qualifications, Level 2 Maths and English courses and prepares learners for the world of work. Learners have the opportunity to progress to Level 3 courses including Extended Diplomas, and the programme also prepares learners for Apprenticeships and employment. Assessment will be through a combination of external examination and coursework.

### EXTENDED DIPLOMA LEVEL 3

How long is it? Two years - In year one you will complete a Level 3 Foundation Diploma before progressing to gain the full Extended Diploma at the end of Year 2 unless otherwise stated.

What do you need? Four GCSEs at Grade 4 to include either English Language or Literature and/ or Maths. A Merit on a Level 2 Diploma in an appropriate subject can also be considered (plus English and/or Maths).

What is it? Previously known as the National Diploma, the 180-credit, 13-unit qualification is referred to as the Extended Diploma. This Diploma is equivalent to three subjects at A Level. It is an excellent route if you have decided on the broad area of employment you wish to pursue. The combination of a range of specialist modules with the depth of knowledge acquired enables you to progress successfully into higher education or into employment. You will also be required to undertake several hours of independent study. Assessment is through coursework, external written exams and evaluation of practical skills.

# EXTENDED CERTIFICATE LEVEL 3 A LEVEL

**FOUIVALENT** 

How long is it? Two years.

What do you need? Four GCSEs at Grade 4 or above or a Level 2 Diploma in appropriate subjects.

What is it? The Level 3 Extended Certificate/Diploma are an excellent addition if you are studying A Levels. They can add breadth to an academic programme of study and provide a vocationally relevant dimension. The six-unit qualification is equivalent to one A Level. Assessment is through coursework and evaluation of practical skills including a final major project.

What do you need? Five GCSEs at Grade 4 or above in appropriate subjects, to include English Language or Literature and/or Maths at Grade 5 or above and with specific relevant subjects related to your A Level choices at Grade 6 and above.

What is it? Advanced Level programmes consist of formal lectures, class activities and assessments, set homework and problem solving. For each subject, you will also be required to undertake several hours of independent study. Modern study facilities are available in the College and successful students use these effectively.

We strongly encourage a broad programme for A Level students. Most subject specifications are assessed by examination but some include coursework assessment. All A Levels at the College will be delivered in the new linear format with no qualification at the end of year one. Academic assessment for Linear A Levels will take place at the end of two years of study. Students must study a minimum of three A Levels.



The lecturers will challenge you to explore and experiment with a range of different practices and materials to achieve a foundation of a full set of artistic skills to before giving you the freedom to explore vour own ideas.

# **COURSES**

# ART & DESIGN - FINE ART A LEVEL

The A Level Fine Art programme gives you the creative freedom to develop your skill set in drawing, painting, printmaking and a broad range of mixed media artwork. Here at Penwith College we cater for all approaches: from figurative, to abstract, and to conceptual.

- Why choose this course? Do you enjoy drawing, would you like to explore a broad range of materials and processes, improve vour skills and knowledge, work creatively, see and understand the world in a different way? This course develops your skills and thinking, either as a personally enriching interest or as a progression towards a career within the creative industries. This course offers a range of varied and exciting workshops, to develop skills and knowledge that is fundamental to the world of art and design. The course gradually builds around personal interests, to develop vour creativity.
- Where will it take me? A qualification in Fine Art is highly valued by many universities and employers. As a 'classical' 'creative' subject it is applicable to almost any progression in art and design and an excellent subject to complement courses such as Architecture, History of Art, Film, Prosthetics and Theatrical Make Up, Art Therapy and Education.

# ART & DESIGN - ILLUSTRATION/ GRAPHICS A LEVEL

Do you possess a lively, enquiring mind? Do you enjoy developing your ideas through drawing and utilising a range of processes towards a final project? During the Illustration/ Graphics course, you will learn to develop design solutions, exploring the power of visual communication as an invaluable commercial tool.

- Why choose this course? The course is structured to support and develop your confidence and individual strengths, from illustrative and traditional studio-based skills through to more graphics and digitally based practice, allowing for a broad and creative approach to design. The start of the course involves a series of workshops covering traditional skills such as experimental drawing through to digital skills using software such as Adobe Photoshop, Illustrator and InDesign. These workshops allow you to develop and bank a broad range of varied skills to draw upon as the course progresses and you begin your individual responses to a brief.
- Where will it take me? You can progress directly from A Level to an arts degree such as Graphic Design, Visual Communication, Illustration, Games Design and Multi-Media Design. Employment as a graphic designer is the clearest route but this course also offers a way into illustration or, with further study, animation; you could work for the media, an advertising company or design agency.

## ART, DESIGN & MEDIA LEVEL 1 DIPLOMA

As a student on this course, you will be challenged to investigate a diverse range of art and design media, develop your practical skills and enhance your presentation abilities with a view to progressing onto a higher-level course of study.

- Why choose this course? This course is a fast paced, creatively rewarding, hands on practical subject. In art and design, you will explore how to successfully express your ideas visually and how to develop your practical skills in different artistic techniques and processes. The Level 1 Art and Design Diploma encourages you to be experimental with your approach and to explore lots of visual ideas which will lead to you making exciting two-dimensional and three-dimensional finished work.
- Where will it take me? The Art, Design and Media course will provide preparation for further study at Level 2 or an Apprenticeship. During the course, you will create a portfolio of diverse art and design work, which can be taken to interviews.

#### ART & DESIGN Level 2 Diploma

This course is a fast-paced, creatively rewarding, hands-on subject. You will explore how to successfully express your ideas visually and how to develop your practical skills in different artistic techniques and processes.

- Why choose this course? The Level 2 Art and Design Diploma encourages you to be experimental with your approach and to explore lots of visual ideas, which will lead to you making exciting twodimensional and three-dimensional finished work. You will have the opportunity to explore and discover new ways of working with methods of production and specialist techniques in areas such as drawing, painting, printmaking, graphic design, textiles and sculpture. You will also research the lives and work of other selected artists and designers related to each project. This research will inspire and inform your own creative outcomes alongside developing your verbal and written analytical skills and use of formal art and design language.
- Where will it take me? The Level 2 Diploma gives you the ideal foundation of skills to then progress onto the Level 3 Extended Diploma in Art & Design or a range of other Level 3 programmes within the College.

## ART, DESIGN & COMMUNICATION - CREATIVE PRACTICE LEVEL 3 EXTENDED DIPLOMA

You will be challenged to investigate a diverse range of art and design media, develop your own innovative visual language and realise your creative potential both as an individual and as a collaborator.

- Why choose this course? Do you possess a lively, enquiring mind? - Where will it take me? For any career in art and design, it is recommended that you go into higher education to do a specialist degree or foundation degree. Your portfolio of work is designed to get you accepted onto a course in higher education such as a BA (Hons) or a Foundation Diploma in Art and Design.

#### AUTOMOTIVE MAINTENANCE LEVEL 1 DIPLOMA

The role of a car mechanic is to maintain and repair cars and vans to ensure that they are safe to be on our roads. This course is your first step to becoming a Service Vehicle Technician, capable of fixing a wide variety of automotive faults.

- Why choose this course? This course is an introduction to a career as a car mechanic. You will gain an understanding of the motor industry and have an opportunity to apply vehicle maintenance and repair skills in a practical and realistic way. You will follow a programme of study that enables progression to further courses and employment within the motor industry. You will gain confidence by developing independent learning skills and will learn how vehicle maintenance and repair activities are carried out safely; you will also learn how important the role of a mechanic is to keeping so many different parts of the country operating smoothly.
- Where will it take me? 

A sound understanding of key business concepts are important to anyone aspiring to a career in business management. This course will help you gain a good understanding of the processes and practices a business must undertake to make key business decisions.

#### • Why choose this course?

Whether it is setting up your own small business or working for a global multinational, many of the key areas of understanding and useful skills are introduced within the A Level Business Studies course. You will be provided with a valuable insight into the world of business and why organisations make the decisions that they do and how this impacts upon markets and individuals. ## INTRODUCTORY CERTIFICATE IN HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE LEVEL 1 CERTIFICATE

The purpose of this qualification is to develop the transferable skills, attributes and behaviours needed for learners to progress to further study and ultimately to employment.

- Why choose this course? Topic 3: Software Development & Emerging Technologies: You will learn how to program a number of components and devices including; temperature sensors, robotic arms and robotic buggies. These will be connected to a Raspberry Pi computer. There will be an opportunity to try out emerging technologies such as 3D printing and virtual reality.

• Why choose this academy? Run in partnership with local businesses, the Computing Academy will enhance your technical skills and employability, preparing you for a career in the fast-changing field of computing.

• What can I expect?

The Academy aims to build your computing abilities in a wide range of areas to allow for a breadth of opportunity and development.

#### **ESPORTS ACADEMY**

- Why choose this academy?

- What can I expect? #### A LEVEL COMPUTER SCIENCE

If you enjoy learning about the fundamental principles and concepts behind Computer Science and how software is engineered, then Computer Science will stretch and challenge you, helping you to think creatively, analytically, logically and to apply practical mathematical skills.

#### • Why choose this course?

The basis of this course is computation, both in theory and practice. Computer Science is an academic subject that requires you to be systematic and logical, and so often lends itself to the more technically minded student. The course will provide you with valuable skills in how we use programming languages and how digital technology is used. You'll start off by developing practical skills C#. You will have the opportunity to perform systems analysis, software engineering and program construction. Then vou'll move on to learn how software interacts with hardware, in particular the role of the operating system, data structures and processes and how the principles of hardware impact on software and data communication.

## • Where will it take me? The many career possibilities that are available to you with Computer Science include system analysis, computer programming, animation and many more. Previous students now work around the world for companies ranging from Google to local businesses working with robotics and embedded systems.

### INFORMATION & CREATIVE TECHNOLOGY LEVEL 2 AWARD

Upon successful completion of this course, you will have a comprehensive understanding of modern Information Technology. You will be well prepared to progress on the Level 3 Extended Diploma in Information Technology or enter the workplace as an IT professional.

#### Why choose this course?

Lessons take place in specialist IT rooms with networked PCs. Your lecturers will be specialists in their field who will teach you through a variety of demonstrations, lectures and by helping you undertake a variety of practical tasks. You will have access to hardware and networking lab facilities for the practical parts of the course. This course has been streamlined to help with progression onto the Level 3 equivalent, and whether you have existing knowledge or not, this course will stretch and challenge you and your IT skills.



#### CHOOSE ENGLISH AND LANGUAGES FOR CAREERS IN:

- Copy Writing

#### ENGLISH LANGUAGE

You will study various texts including articles, speeches and advertisements, while focusing on fundamental questions about language: what does your use of language say about you? Where do words come from? How do children learn to speak and write?

#### • Why choose this course?

Imagine vou could take vour innermost thoughts and insert them into someone else's mind. Well, you already can: it's called language. In English Language, we ask ourselves different questions... How does the analysis of language help to solve crime? How do we learn to speak and write? Is language being corrupted or is linguistic change gr8? You will also consider how identity is created through choices in language. Why do you say please? How does celebrity culture shape language? What impact can geographical and social factors such as gender, age and ethnicity have on identity? This is just a snapshot of what you will discover.

### • Where will it take me? This course is highly valued by universities and employers and is an excellent subject to complement many courses, such as English Literature, Psychology, Sociology, Media Studies and Education. Some university courses also require A Level English Literature.

#### ENGLISH LANGUAGE & LITERATURE

#### **A LEVEL**

Do you love analysing literature and the language of the world around us? Prepare to study a wide variety of texts that will hone your critical thinking and perceptive abilities, whilst also developing your creative writing skills.

- Why choose this course? Love writing? Like to analyse...well. everything? English Language and Literature allows you to be creative - not only through your fiction and non-fiction coursework - but also through the creative approach you can take in your analytical work. How? This multidisciplinary course approaches analysis from both a linguistic and literary point of view. Word class? Sure. Imagery? Of course! This A Level differs from those focused primarily on literature by extending its coverage to explore non-literary and non-fiction texts. You can expect to study prose, drama and poetry, but also a range of texts such as newspaper articles, online copy and adverts.
- Where will it take me? The course provides an excellent foundation for any degree which requires an essay-based subject. English graduates have gone on to pursue Law, Medicine, Journalism, Business Management and Education, as well as careers in academia and the civil service, to name but a few.

#### ENGLISH LITERATURE

By studying English Literature, you will learn the vital skills of close textual analysis and literary criticism. You will compare and contrast a range of exciting, challenging, and stimulating works from 1600-2021, while considering their historical and cultural contexts.

- Why choose this course? If you enjoy reading, analysing, and comparing literary texts, then this is the course for you. You will be introduced to Gothic fiction. which explores the dark extremes of human consciousness, and is used by writers to comment on and criticise the society in which they write. You will study texts such as Angela Carter's The Bloody Chamber, a series of creative reinterpretations of traditional folk tales, Mary Shelley's Frankenstein which explores the dangers of attempting to control the natural world, or Bram Stoker's Dracula. the original vampire novel. You will also study a play such as Tennessee Williams' 1940s drama A Streetcar Named Desire or Tom Stoppard's Arcadia, great poetry by Christina Rossetti, Milton, or Coleridge.
- Where will it take me? A qualification in English Literature is highly valued by universities and employers and many university courses welcome an A Level in English Literature in application for a variety of courses.

#### **FRENCH A LEVEL**

Develop your speaking, listening, reading and writing skills in French while broadening your knowledge of France and other French speaking countries.

- Why choose this course? You will build on your existing knowledge of French and delve into a variety of topics which really give you an inroad into Frenchspeaking culture, history, and life. You will learn vocabulary based on these topic areas as well as grammar rules, which will enable you to make sense of and use the language accurately. You will use a wide range of materials and have access to additional books, films. TV programmes and digital resources through the college intranet and learning resource centres.
- Where will it take me? A qualification in French is highly valued by universities and employers alike. At university, French can be studied alone or combined with almost any other subject. Employment prospects are very good for graduates with a language qualification.

#### **SPANISH A LEVEL**

Develop your speaking, listening, reading and writing skills while broadening your knowledge of Spain and other Spanish speaking countries.

• Why choose this course? You will build on your existing knowledge of Spanish and delve into a variety of topics which really give you an inroad into Hispanic culture, history, and life. You will learn vocabulary based on these topic areas as well as grammar rules, which will enable you to make sense of and use the language accurately. In addition to the topics, you will study a film and a novel, both of which tie in usefully with other themes across the two years. All of this information from the classroom will be reinforced in homework and also during individual weekly conversation sessions. You will also have the opportunity to take part in one of our language visits to Spain, where your ability to speak will come to life and you will gain first-hand experience of the culture you have been studvina.

#### Where will it take me?

Many linguists go into broadcast journalism, politics, teaching, translation, or the Civil Service. At university Spanish can be studied with almost any other subject, such as Business, Law and Science, and is a language of huge global importance.



#### HAIR & BEAUTY SKILLS LEVEL 1 DIPLOMA

This course will lead you into the exciting industry of Hairdressing and Beauty Therapy. You will learn different techniques of styling, plaiting and twisting, along with beauty therapy skin care and basic make-up techniques. This programme will also support the fundamental skills of English, Maths and employability supporting the career pathway of your choice. We will focus on how we present ourselves, particularly in an ever-changing fashion-conscious world, the course will also help you to develop your skills in communicating knowledge about hairdressing and beauty therapy to non-specialists and the general public.

- Why choose this course? - Why choose this academy?
  If you are curious, inquisitive and enjoy learning, then the Academic Academy is for you. Explore new and interesting ideas that broaden your knowledge and supplement your College studies.
- What can I expect? The Academic Academy is a 30-week programme of lectures and seminars designed to stretch, challenge and provide support for students who want to apply for selective universities. It is taken alongside your full-time programme and only requires a commitment of two hours a week





and aims to increase your support applications to most competitive universities. We'll introduce you to new ideas and new ways of looking at the world; every Wednesday afternoon you will have a lecture by our own staff and external guests, with previous speakers including a lord, an Oxford professor, BBC national newsreader and the Director of Experiments at CERN. This is followed by a choice of seminar. The academy also provides Oxbridge support for any students who wish to apply to Oxford or Cambridge universities.



## **COURSES**

## **GEOGRAPHY A LEVEL**

A Level Geography offers you an exciting issues-based approach to studying both physical and human aspects of the subject. Applying your newly-developed geographical knowledge, understanding and skills to the world around you, you will engage critically with a wide range of complex contemporary issues such as tectonic hazards, climate change, resource security, globalisation and superpowers.

- Why choose this course?

  Michael Palin (former President of the Royal Geographical Society) has said that: "Geography explains the past, illuminates the present and prepares us for the future. What could be more important than that?" Inspired by Geography as one of the key disciplines relevant to understanding the world's changing places and peoples, you will also develop a sense of achievement as you grow as a critical, independent thinker and as an informed and engaged citizen.
- Where will it take me? A qualification in Geography is highly valued by many universities and employers alike. Geography is also an excellent subject to complement many other courses, such as Environmental Studies, Politics and Sociology.

## **HISTORY A LEVEL**

The study of History helps us understand and explain the past and is an endlessly fascinating subject. The research, evaluation and analytical skills acquired are desirable in Higher Education and employment. Students will also develop their understanding of major world events.

- Why choose this course? In Modern History, you will study the rise and fall of the British Empire 1857 1967. This provides an interesting contrast to the second module the Cold War, 1945 1991. The third module is a Non-Examined Assessment on the USA 1763 1865, focussing on the period when the USA won its freedom from Britain then descended into Civil War.
- Where will it take me? History is a popular and highly regarded qualification by both universities and employers. The skills that you acquire as a historian, the ability to think clearly, to weigh up arguments and to analyse problems, are highly desirable. History students gain access to a wide variety of careers including business, law, marketing, media, and politics as well as career pathways including archaeologist, archivist, curator and teacher.

## PHILOSOPHY OF RELIGION & ETHICS

A LEVEL

Religious Studies invites you to explore philosophical beliefs that have shaped Western civilisation. The course provides a critical understanding of ideas about the self, the world we live in, moral values and the meaning of life and death.

- Why choose this course? Within this course you will consider how Religion, Ethics and Philosophy are intertwined within culture. law. medicine, social care, environment and politics. If you are looking to pursue a career as a lawver. politician, teacher, doctor, social activist, diplomat, aid worker, police officer (or any job that works with people) then this course will provide you with a range of transferable skills essential for the modern workplace. Students are trained in the application of rigorous logic through the development of a wide variety of skills including independent critical thought, analytical reasoning and persuasive communication.
- Philosophy of Religion & Ethics is recognised as a respected entrance qualification by all universities, and employers are aware that it helps to develop an individual's ability to communicate, work with others and solve complex problems. Given the emphasis on ethics in this course, it might be useful for those considering careers in law or medicine.

Where will it take me?



## **POLITICS A LEVEL**

Studying A Level Politics will give you an enhanced understanding of the world around you and who shapes the structures and manifestations of power.

## • Why choose this course?

The course gives you an understanding of British politics to begin with and an introduction to the key ideologies in politics. In the 2nd year you study global politics and so examine the key concepts of the course focusing on how they operate on the macro level between states and intergovernmental organisations. Politics is constantly changing, and you will be required to keep abreast of those changes: this makes politics a dynamic and interesting subject. This, combined with the course content, will enable you to reflect on your own political beliefs in a structured and rigorous way.

## • Where will it take me? A qualification in Politics is highly valued by many universities and employers alike. Many of our Politics students go on to study Politics and related courses including International Politics, Law, and History at a range of prestigious universities.

## **PSYCHOLOGY A LEVEL**

If you are interested in people and curious to explore reasons for their behaviour, then this is the course for you. Successful Psychology students are scientists and apply objective research methods to answer fundamental questions about human beings.

- Why choose this course? Successful Psychology students have an appetite for understanding how scientific principles can be applied to human behaviour and high achieving Psychology students develop analytical and problem-solving skills, have a keen eye for detail and enjoy using evidence to develop academic arguments. Alongside psychological concepts and theories you will acquire desirable soft skills such as communication, team working and relationship building, and specific competences in data collection, statistical analysis and report writing.
- Where will it take me? Studying Psychology will equip you with numeracy, communication, IT, organisation and analysis skills and provides a valuable background for a variety of careers including management, personnel, advertising, marketing, teaching, uniformed services, nursing and health and welfare. Further training and experience beyond degree level is usually required for qualification as a professional psychologist; clinical, educational, forensic or organisational.

## **SOCIOLOGY A LEVEL**

Sociology can be best understood as a study of the changing world. Within the topic we seek to explain broad ideas, such as; why certain roles are 'gender-specific', why people commit crimes and what attracts people to join cults. This subject will broaden your mind and provide you with the ability to think critically, a skill that is highly-valued at university and in employment.

Why choose this course? Sociology is arguably one of the most relevant topics in contemporary society. We identify various social inequalities and ongoing consequences of these. We discuss what power is, who has it and how it impacts our lives. There will be consideration of the individual experience and its existence within wider society. A Level Sociology will introduce you to points of view on society, including those which promote conservative values (Functionalism), to those which argue for change (Marxism and Feminism). In Sociology much of what we investigate is open to interpretation: the information will be presented to your group and via discussions and debates, you will be encouraged to reach your own opinion.

## Where will it take me?

Sociology is highly valued by many universities and employers and provides students with valuable analytical and evaluative skills. The objective and rigorous nature of this subject can lead to a range of careers, such as management, human resources, social work, the civil service, the criminal justice system, national or local government and law.



• Why choose this academy?

Mathematics students have the opportunity to enter for the UKMT Senior Mathematics Challenge and those who achieve very high scores may progress to the Senior Maths Kangaroo or British Mathematics Olympiad. Each year, four students represent Truro College in the UKMT Senior Team Challenge, success in which leads to representing Cornwall at the National finals in London.

## • What can I expect?

In maths, the STEM Academy also stretches and challenges students by working on problem-solving activities, which take them beyond the scope of that covered during class lectures.





This is then extended towards preparation for university admissions tests in mathematics (TMUA, AEA and STEP papers). These are nationally recognised additional qualifications, which are essential for applications for an increasing number of Maths degrees.

## MATHEMATICS A LEVEL

Mathematics is a challenging and stimulating course that will encourage you to develop your mathematical skills, improve your ability to think logically and enable you to determine solutions to a wide range of problems. If you enjoyed studying GCSE Maths, particularly the more algebraic topics, and would like to significantly improve your mathematical skills, then this would be an ideal subject for you.

• Why choose this course? You will need to be good at algebra before you start the course. Throughout the course you will learn many new mathematical techniques and apply them to a variety of practical situations. Studying Mathematics will support the study of several other subjects, in particular Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Geography, Psychology, Computer Science, Economics and Business Studies. The course provides an excellent preparation for a wide range of university courses, such as Engineering. Sciences. Medicine. Accountancy. Architecture and Computer Science. It is also considered to be a facilitating subject for many other courses. Mathematics is a versatile qualification that is well respected by employers.

• Where will it take me?



By building performance, directing and design skills we encourage learners to articulate their personal and artistic viewpoints and make exciting, challenging theatre performances. Drama is a collaborative course and will help you to develop important communication skills and confidence, contributing to your personal and social development. Through studying drama, we recognise the important role it plays in helping us to understand social issues. human interaction. and the wider world.
- Where will it take me? The skills that you will develop on this course are transferable to all areas of further study. Our students have the option of university to study any degree subject or a vocational route such as drama school to study acting, musical theatre or design. Drama is also an excellent subject to complement many courses, such as English literature, dance, classics, humanities, any media-related course and education.

## MUSIC PERFORMANCE LEVEL 3 DIPLOMA A LEVEL EQUIVALENT

This course is studied alongside a programme of A levels. The intent of the course is to develop a range of skills necessary to succeed as a musical performer within the current music industry.

• Why choose this course? The programme gives a broad overview of the sector, with a focus on performance, including musical skills development and professional practice. In addition to the music sector-specific content. this qualification gives learners transferable and higher-order skills that are valued by higher education providers and employers, for example performance techniques, communication skills, team working. It also gives learners an opportunity to focus on their personal vocal/instrumental technique. In the first year you will complete two main units that focus on musical styles, rehearsal strategies and performance skills. In the second year of the course students will complete two units focusing on development of musical theory and professional practice in the music industry.

• Where will it take me? Music can be combined successfully with most other A Level subjects. It is very useful for those intending to teach and can lead to a career in the recording industry, arts administration and performing arts.





## MUSIC PERFORMANCE & PRODUCTION LEVEL 2 AWARD

Are you looking for a practical and creative music course which includes performing on stage and producing your own music? This course allows you to develop a range of professional music industry skills such as composition, listening skills, rehearsal processes and music technology.

- Why choose this course?
  Developed to provide you with an understanding of Music
  Performance and Production as a collaborative activity and prepare you for the reality of the sector, progression and paths available to you. The qualification has been designed for students who have an interest in music performance and/or music production or a related subject who wish to explore and extend this interest via a full-time, immersive learning experience.
- What will I learn? You will learn how to develop your music skills through performing in a group, composing your own pieces and working in a variety of different musical styles. Through a close analysis of the music industry, you will discover how to plan your career, develop your own personal music style and propel yourself into the local and national music scene. The music industry is one of the driving forces behind the British creative industries that provides some of the most diverse career opportunities and creative challenges, plus it is also really good fun.

- Why choose this course?
  You'll be provided with the skills, knowledge and understanding necessary to progress to further study and training in a range of music performance and production disciplines. This course is undertaken alongside a suite of A Levels and is an equivalent A Level qualification.
- Where will it take me?

## INTRODUCTION TO PROFESSIONAL COOKERY STUDIES

Hospitality and professional cookery fundamentals, this qualification will take you through the foundations of this industry.

• Why choose this academy?
If you are interested in following a career in medicine, dentistry or veterinary science then the Medics' Academy is for you! The process of applying to these highly competitive courses has multiple stages and can be confusing - the Medics' Academy is here to help guide you through this process and to optimise your chances of receiving an offer.

 What can I expect? The Truro and Penwith Medics' Academy is run in partnership with students



from Exeter Medical School as part of the Widening Access initiative. We also work closely with exacademy members at all stages of their careers, Foundation year doctors, GPs, dentists and vets to give you the widest exposure to careers in this field. The first year is about building your knowledge and skills through talks, interactive workshops and seminars, in which you will learn communication skills, manual dexterity and basic clinical skills. You will also learn about the application process and the different types of medical courses that are available. We can even help you to find work experience, which is essential for a successful application.

In the second year, you will receive advice on writing personal statements, admissions tests and choosing the right medical course for you. After your application has been submitted you will have the opportunity to take part in two mock interviews and a full day of MMI training, enabling you to perform at your best when you have your real interview and give you the confidence to succeed.

# **STEM ACADEMY**





## **CHEMISTRY PATHWAY**

- Why choose this academy? The Chemistry Pathway supports students to explore their interest in chemistry further.
- What can I expect? Chemistry students can be entered for the Cambridge Chemistry Challenge Lower Sixth competition at the end of their first year. The first round is a written exam that is sat in June, and those who perform best will win an invitation to a residential camp at the University of Cambridge at the end of August.

second year students work towards competing in the Royal Society of Chemistry: UK Chemistry Olympiad. Round one consists of a challenging written test of chemical knowledge, which is sat in January. The top-performing students from participating UK schools are chosen by the Royal Society of Chemistry Olympiad Selection Committee to progress to round two. Questions are based on real-world chemistry problems that often stimulate much debate, raising awareness of what chemistry is all about. They are also an opportunity to develop and showcase some of the skills required for studying chemistry at university and beyond.

## **PHYSICS PATHWAY**

- Why choose this academy?
  Physics students have an opportunity take part in a national physics competition and to develop their confidence in the subject.
- What can I expect? In Year 1 there is an opportunity to take part in the BPhO Senior Physics Challenge. This is not merely for the very top students, but for all those who like to engage in problem solving questions and developing those skills. The Challenge will consist of questions that test only core subject knowledge and application but are more advanced than students are generally be acquainted with. In Year 2, selected students will be invited to the BPhO paper which will stretch even A\* students. They require the student to solve complex Physics problems in a set time.

Academies are part of our wider enrichment programme integrated into our curriculum provision to promote development and excellence.



## **BIOLOGY A LEVEL**

If you enjoy learning about life and living organisms and want to delve deeper into concepts that you have been introduced to at GCSE, from biochemistry and cell biology through to behaviour and ecology, then A Level Biology will offer you an exciting, challenging and stimulating area of study.

- Why choose this course? Biology encompasses the cellular basis of living things, the transformation of energy that underlies the activities of life, and the genetic basis for inheritance in organisms. You will study the evolutionary relationships between organisms and the diversity of life on earth, to include microorganisms, plants and animals. The structural and functional relationships studied in biology draw on the sciences of chemistry and physics for its foundations and applies the laws of these disciplines to living things.
- Where will it take me? A Level Biology is a highly respected qualification that is valued for most degree subjects and by employers worldwide. To broaden your higher education options, it is recommended that you study this course alongside A Level Chemistry. Biology also opens up a wide range of opportunities for university level study, including Medicine, Nursing, Dentistry, Physiotherapy, Veterinary Science, Zoology, Radiography, Agriculture and Horticulture, Marine Biology, Biochemistry, Genetics, Nutrition, Botany, Forensic Science and many other possibilities.

## **CHEMISTRY A LEVEL**

A Level Chemistry will give you an exciting insight into the contemporary world of chemistry. It covers the key concepts of chemistry and practical skills are integrated throughout the course. This combination of academic challenge and practical focus makes the prospect of studying A Level Chemistry highly appealing.

- Why choose this course? You will learn about chemistry in a range of different contexts and the impact it has on industry and many aspects of everyday life. You will learn to investigate and solve chemical problems in a range of contexts. If you enjoy the study of the substances that make both us and our surroundings then chemistry is the subject for you. Chemistry is everywhere: in the food we eat and the water we drink, from the clothes we wear and our mobile phones to the medicines that keep us healthy.
- Where will it take me? If you want to study Medicine, Dentistry, Pharmacy or Veterinary Science then chemistry is essential. An understanding of chemistry is desirable for the study of many subjects, is valued highly by universities and equips you for further study in the sciences as well as areas such as law and finance. Studying chemistry will provide you with problem-solving, communication, creativity and teamwork skills; hence chemical scientists are much sought after and can pursue careers in many exciting and varied fields of work.





## **COURSES**

## ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE A LEVEL

Do you want to gain an insight into the scientific processes that control and affect the environment? If so, through studying Environmental Science you will gain an understanding of how our Earth works, how human activity impacts upon the Earth and the strategies used to minimise the problems that may be caused.

#### • Why choose this course?

This course can lead to university courses in various environmental science subjects, environmental science careers form a major section of the government's UK shortage occupation list and so job prospects are good. You need a strong science background and so should consider linking this with other sciences, however it's a great subject to broaden out a more humanities or arts-based programme. This subject can give the opportunity for practical learning in many of the topics covered and field work, trips and visits will form a significant part of your study programme.

• Where will it take me? The course could lead you to a career with an environment agency, National Trust, Forestry Commission, local wildlife trusts, environmental consultancies, National Parks, recycling organisations, waste management and water quality organisations or further study at university level.

#### **PHYSICS A LEVEL**

If you are interested in questions like "what happens if I go into a black hole?", "what is a Higgs Boson?" and "what happens if I travel near to the speed of light?", then the A Level Physics specification will challenge you to consider these questions – and many more!

- Why choose this course? Physics allows you to understand the fundamental structure of the universe from atoms (or smaller!) to galaxies (or bigger!) and how the matter within the universe interacts. You will discover that the same underlying physical laws can be applied from everyday situations such as electric circuits or theme park rides to complex situations like particle accelerators or black holes! Practical lectures will enable you to develop confidence in working experimentally, as well as increasing your knowledge and skills regarding scientific method, data analysis and the presenting of data.
- Where will it take me? To study physics, electronics or engineering at degree level vou will need A Level Physics. However, an understanding of physics is also desirable for Mathematics, Computer Science. Chemistry, Geology, Medicine, Dentistry, Veterinary Science and Environmental Science university courses. Studying the physical sciences at university level provides you with problem solving, communication, creativity and teamwork skills and opportunities in careers within many exciting fields of work including meteorology, finance, law and iournalism.

#### APPLIED SCIENCE -BIOMEDICAL SCIENCE

## LEVEL 3 EXTENDED DIPLOMA

Scientists use the same skills on a daily basis to attempt to solve current issues. This course is designed to give you a detailed understanding of aspects of science with an emphasis on the skills and knowledge used in the field of biomedical sciences.

- Why choose this course? Over the two years of study you will develop the scientific knowledge, practical skills and problem-solving abilities to enable you to progress into employment or onto a range of Higher Education courses. You will study a range of core scientific units and specialist units with a particular emphasis on the knowledge, skills and techniques used in the field of biomedical science. Throughout the course you will develop your scientific understanding and practical skills through a series of assignments. external exams and challenging investigations which utilise some of the techniques used by scientists in the workplace.
- Where will it take me? Scientific skills are always in demand in the workplace and a wide range of careers are possible including working in hospital laboratories, research laboratories, school or college laboratories or quality control laboratories (for example in the food and drink industry). The course is well respected by universities and as a result can lead to a variety of science-based courses at higher education.

## SPORT & EXERCISE SCIENCE LEVEL 3 EXTENDED CERTIFICATE A LEVEL EOUIVALENT

This course equivalent to one A Level and is ideal if you are interested in undertaking a sport or health related career. You will develop a wide range of skills and abilities that will enable you to either progress onto Higher Education or into employment in sports related industries. especially into those requiring a scientific background. This course will suit you if you have an interest in the physiological and psychological approaches to developing groups and individuals across a wide range of activities from grassroots through to those at the top of the sports performance pyramid.

- Why choose this course? You will be studying a range of sport and health-related topics whilst developing a strong academic approach to these topics. You will discover how to apply theoretical and practical techniques to analyse and improve the sporting performance of both yourself and others, as well as improve general health and fitness.
- Where will it take me?
  Recognised by UCAS for
  university application, this is
  particularly suitable for students
  wanting a career in Healthcare
  (Physiotherapy, Sports Therapy,
  Osteopath, Chiropractor or
  Podiatrist) or in Sport.

### PUBLIC SERVICES

If you enjoy studying a variety of subjects chosen to help develop your confidence, understanding and skills, this progression course could be for you. This qualification will allow you to develop knowledge and understanding by applying your learning and skills in a work-related environment.

- Why choose this course? You will learn through a range of methods including practical experiences and theory-based lessons. You will be taught in classroom lectures, presentations from Public Service teams. practical sessions and group discussions. The Progression 2 Public Services pathway allows you to study the BTEC Certificate in Public Services and is broadly equivalent to two GCSEs. BTEC Firsts are vocationally related qualifications, where you will develop knowledge and understanding by applying your learning and skills in a work-related scenario.
- Where will it take me? You will be able to make informed choices with regard to a career in the uniformed public services. You will also have developed academic and practical skills that may be applicable in other work situations or will enable you to progress to Level 3 qualifications in areas such as Public Services or Sport.

#### SPORT LEVEL 2 DIPLOMA

The Progression 2 Sport pathway allows you to study the NCFE Level 2 Certificate in Sport, NCFE qualifications are vocationally related qualifications, where you develop knowledge & understanding by applying your learning and skills in a work-related context.

- Why choose this course? This pathway will provide training and experiences for those intending to work in the Sport industry and will provide the opportunity to develop a range of practical skills and techniques, personal skills and attributes essential for successful performance in working life in this area. If you enjoy studying a variety of subjects chosen to help develop your confidence, understanding and abilities and then applying them in and out of the classroom, this progression could be for you. Units such as: Sport Participation, Anatomy & Physiology and Coaching are some of the units you will study over the 1 year course. Alongside the NCFE Certificate you will work towards OCN Work Skills qualifications. These qualifications are designed to provide learners with a range of employability skills that are key to preparing them for the workplace and are to assist learners in acquiring the skills, attributes and behaviours that are needed to enter and succeed in any future progression routes.
- Where will it take me? In completing this qualification you will be able to progress onto further study, training, or employment and this will enable you to make informed choices with regard to a career in the Sport sector.

## ENTRY TO THE UNIFORMED SERVICES LEVEL 3 EXTENDED DIPLOMA

This course is designed to provide learners with an in-depth understanding of the principles of the uniformed public services sector and will allow them to explore the various avenues of work within it.

- Why choose this course? This qualification aims to provide learners with an understanding of the uniformed public services sector, the opportunity to investigate career opportunities in the uniformed services. We will prepare the learners for a variety of recruitment interviews. Learners will understand the personal commitment and fitness requirements needed to be employed in a uniformed service role. How external organisations impact on and influence the work of the uniformed services. An awareness of how uniformed services organisations respond in emergency situations will also be assessed. Learners will have the opportunity to understand and develop the skills and qualities needed to work in a range of uniformed services e.g. leadership skills, coaching skills, conflict management, personal protection, teamwork, communication, navigation, drill.
- Where will it take me? This course will help students to apply for careers in the armed services, justice services, emergency services, local or national government and other security services.



## **COURSES**

## SPORT LEVEL 3 EXTENDED DIPLOMA


This course would suit individuals that have an interest in undertaking a career in sport or health related areas such as sports nutrition, sports psychology, teaching physical education, sports therapy, sports development and sports coaching, amongst others.

- Why choose this course? By studying this qualification, you will develop a wide range of skills and abilities that will enable you to either progress onto higher education or into employment in sports-related industries. You will be studying a broad range of sport and health related topics whilst developing a scientific and academic approach to these topics. The sport industry contributes billions of pounds each year to the UK economy and is a continuously growing sector. The industry employs more than 400,000 people and offers many career openings in a range of areas including management, fitness, leisure, recreation, outdoors, wellbeing, elite performance, coaching and teaching.
- Where will it take me? This course prepares you for both employment and progression onto higher education courses such as the Foundation Degree in Sports Coaching at Truro and Penwith College, or a degree programme at another university. Common career paths for sport students include sports coaching, teaching, strength and conditioning coach, sports therapist and personal trainer.

## SPORT & EXERCISE SCIENCE LEVEL 3 EXTENDED DIPLOMA

This course equivalent to 3
A Levels and is perfect for you if are interested in undertaking a sport or health related career such as sports nutrition, sports psychology, performance analysis, sports therapy or sports coaching, strength and conditioning amongst others.

- Why choose this course? You will develop a range of skills and abilities that will enable you to either progress onto Higher Education or employment in sports related industries, especially into those requiring a scientific background. You will discover how to apply theoretical and practical techniques to analyse and improve the sporting performance of yourself and others, as well as improving general health and fitness. You will be studying a broad range of sport and health related topics whilst developing a strong scientific and academic approach to these topics.
- Where will it take me? This course prepares you for both employment in the health and leisure industry and progression on to higher education to study for a degree in areas related to sport, exercise, health or education. This could include Sports Science, Sports Therapy, Physiotherapy, Nursing, Physical Education, Coaching and Sports Psychology. Courses such as the Foundation Degrees in Sports Rehabilitation or Exercise, Health & Fitness at Truro and Penwith College are available.



### AUTOMOTIVE & ENGINEERING

## AUTO-CARE TECHNICIAN LEVEL 2 APPRENTICESHIP

An Auto-care Technician carries out a range of services and repairs to cars, car derived vans and light goods vehicles, working in an Auto-care or 'Fast-Fit' Centre, which may be part of a national chain or operated by a regional/local independent group/owner.

#### • Why choose this course?

An Auto-care Technician requires a unique combination of technical. retail and customer service skills. They will use a range of tools, measuring and diagnostic equipment to identify and repair simple system faults. The Autocare Technician must demonstrate expertise, not only in the technical elements of their role and have a good grasp of the practical and theoretical aspects of the vehicle systems they service, but also needs to have excellent telephone, customer handling and effective sales skills, as well as strong problem-solving and self-organisation skills. They must be able to work as part of a team but also operate independently. understand how their centre operates from a commercial perspective and how their actions contribute to business results, whilst maintaining a high standard of workmanship.

• Where will it take me? This Level 2 Apprenticeship will suit individuals who are starting a role within a motor vehicle environment, offering a practical approach and a solid platform for anyone wishing to develop in this career path.

## ENGINEERING OPERATIVE LEVEL 2 APPRENTICESHIP

Engineering Operatives are predominantly involved in engineering operations that are key to the success of the Manufacturing and Engineering sector, allowing employers to grow their business while developing a workforce with the relevant skills and knowledge.

#### • Why choose this course?

This is an intermediate level programme for Apprentices wishing to start their career at an Engineering company that requires staff to understand multiple workshop-based Engineering activities. This Apprenticeship is also suitable for Apprentices working at non-Engineering companies where they are required to have a basic understanding of Engineering to undertake maintenance roles. Apprentices will find themselves working in a variety of roles including: fabrication, maintenance, materials, processing or finishing, mechanical manufacturing, technical support and electrical & electronic engineering.

#### Where will it take me?

Engineering Operatives who undergo an Apprenticeship gain craft-level qualifications and can, with experience, move into supervisory positions that can lead to a range of qualifications at various levels.

#### ENGINEERING TECHNICIAN -MACHINIST LEVEL 3 APPRENTICESHIP

Engineering Technicians are found in the Aerospace, Aviation, Automotive, Maritime Defence and wider Advanced Manufacturing and Engineering sector and are predominantly involved in highly skilled, complex work.

#### • Why choose this course?

Apprentices will start a quality career in the Advanced Manufacturing Engineering sector where they will predominantly be involved in highly skilled, complex and precision work machining components from specialist materials using conventional and/or CNC machine tools. Apprentices will learn to use and interpret Engineering data and documentation such as technical drawings, technical data and computer-generated programmes. They will be able to set up, operate and adjust or edit equipment settings as applicable to the machine tool being used.

• Where will it take me? After your Apprenticeship, you will be able to continue your career as a machinist manufacturing engineer and progress within your organisation.

## ENGINEERING TECHNICIAN MECHATRONICS MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN LEVEL 3 APPRENTICESHIP

Engineering Technicians in the Aerospace, Aviation, Automotive, Maritime Defence and wider Advanced Manufacturing and Engineering sector are predominantly involved in highly skilled, complex work and make technical contributions to the design, development, quality assurance, manufacture, installation, commissioning, decommissioning and operation or maintenance of products, equipment, systems, processes or services.

- Why choose this course?
  Start a quality career as a
  Mechatronics Maintenance
  Technician where Apprentices
  will learn to ensure that plant and
  equipment perform to the required
  standard to facilitate production
  targets for safety, quality, delivery
  and cost within High Value
  Manufacturing environments.
- Where will it take me? Gain a qualification that is valued by employers across the engineering sector and is in demand in Cornwall, across the South West and worldwide. Learn, develop and practice the skills required for continued employment and progression.

#### MOTOR VEHICLE SERVICE & MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN LEVEL 3 APPRENTICESHIP

This course supports learners to start their career as an Apprentice Mechanic.
Apprentices will gain an understanding of the Automotive industry and have an opportunity to apply vehicle repair and maintenance skills in a practical and realistic way.

- Why choose this course? Learners will find this course offers the perfect start to a quality career in the motor trade. Motor Vehicle Service and Maintenance Technicians maintain and repair light vehicles such as cars and vans, and work either in dealerships that focus on a particular manufacturer, or in an independent garage that deals with many different makes of vehicles. A Technician will work on all systems found within the vehicle. The day-to-day work ranges from replacing simple parts through to solving complex faults with the use of diagnostic methods and equipment.
- Where will it take me? After your Apprenticeship you can continue in your career as a motor vehicle technician.

#### METAL FABRICATOR LEVEL 3 APPRENTICESHIP

Metal Fabricator Apprentices will work in the Advanced Manufacturing Engineering and Engineering Construction sectors. The broad purpose of the occupation is to carry out metal fabrication work using rolled steel joists, columns, channels, steel plate and metal sheet techniques.

- Why choose this course? Apprentices will start their career as a Metal Fabricator learning to be fully competent in various manual welding processes in all welding positions. The course is suitable for learners who want to advance their welding and fabricating skills. Metal Fabricators use a variety of techniques to cut, form and shape a variety of metal fabricated components and join them by using welding processes, so manual dexterity is essential. There is a high-demand for Metal Fabricators and Multi-Positional Welders in sectors such as: power generation, oil and gas, marine, transport, nuclear, processing. aerospace, pharmaceuticals, construction and many more.
- Where will it take me? After your Apprenticeship, you could look to progress into other roles such as high integrity welder, welding instruction and teaching, welding inspection and management or supervisory roles.

#### ACCOUNTS/FINANCE ASSISTANT LEVEL 2 APPRENTICESHIP

A first step for those with ambitions of entering the exciting world of Accounting, providing Apprentices with both a professional qualification and invaluable work experience in either a firm of accountants or the finance department of an organisation.

#### • Why choose this course?

This Apprenticeship is perfect for those who enjoy working with numbers, are logical and aspire to be successful in the world of Accounting. Apprentices will study with highly experienced lecturers to achieve a world-renowned professional qualification. Students gain the AAT Level 2 Certificate in Accounting and produce a reflective portfolio as part of the taught element of the course.

• Where will it take me? The accounts / finance assistant plays a major role as a member of a team responsible for maintaining an efficient finance function within an organisation. Students can progress onto the Assistant Accountant Level 3 programme.

## CUSTOMER SERVICE PRACTITIONER

### LEVEL 2 APPRENTICESHIP

Suitable for those wishing to start their career in a role providing customer service products and services including; face-to-face, telephone, digital and written contact and communications.

Why choose this course? Learners starting their career with this Apprenticeship can expect to deliver high-quality products and services to the customers of their organisation. The core responsibility will be to provide a high-quality service to customers which will be delivered from the workplace, digitally, or through going out into the customer's own locality. These may be one-off or routine contacts and include dealing with orders, payments, offering advice, guidance and support, meet-and-greet, sales, fixing problems, after care, service recovery or gaining insight through measuring customer satisfaction. Apprentices may be the first point of contact and work in any sector or organisation type.

#### • Where will it take me?

Depending on how your job role develops you could progress onto the Business Administrator Level 3.

#### ASSISTANT ACCOUNTANT

## LEVEL 3 APPRENTICESHIP

This Level 3 course is the ideal next step for someone who has completed a Level 2 or equivalent qualification in Accounting, or has experience working within the profession. The programme will teach Apprentices more advanced techniques in both Financial and Management Accounting.

- Why choose this course? If learners are keen to progress on to the next level in their Accounting career, while working as an Apprentice, gaining a world-renowned professional qualification, then this course provides an excellent platform for future success. Studying with experienced lecturers to achieve the highly regarded AAT Level 3 Diploma in Accounting will boost the learners CV alongside the quality work experience gained with one of Cornwall's top employers.
- Where will it take me? After your Apprenticeship, you will be able to progress onto a Professional Accounting/Taxation Technician Level 4 Apprenticeship.



#### BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR LEVEL 3 APPRENTICESHIP

This Level 3 Apprenticeship is suitable for people who work in administrative support roles and want to learn and further develop their administrative and supervisory skills.

#### • Why choose this course?

This Apprenticeship supports learners to start their career as a Business Administrator where they will apply business processes across an organisation and have highly transferable knowledge. skills and behaviours. Their skills are required in all small and large businesses across the public, private and charitable sectors. The Apprenticeship gives a firm grounding of organisational operations and functional processes, as well as an understanding of the wider working environment. The role may involve working independently or as part of a team and will involve developing. implementing, maintaining and improving administrative services. Business Administrators develop key skills and behaviours to support their own progression towards management responsibilities.

 Where will it take me? You could progress onto various Apprenticeships including; Assistant Accountant, Team Leader/Supervisor, Learning Mentor or Improvement Technician.

#### MARKETING ASSISTANT LEVEL 3 APPRENTICESHIP

A thorough introduction to traditional and digital marketing that will give Apprentices the experience they need to get started in the industry.

- Why choose this course? Recognised by the Chartered Institute of Marketing (CIM), the Level 3 Marketing Assistant Apprenticeship gives learners a thorough grounding in digital and traditional marketing. The programme provides both a wellrecognised qualification and the experience needed to succeed in roles such as Marketing Assistant, Marketing Coordinator or Social Media Manager. Taught by the College's industry-expert tutors, with current experience in the sector, Level 3 Marketing Assistant Apprentices gain the knowledge, competence and confidence to contribute to the marketing activities of the business they work for, making a real difference to business success and developing their own skills along the way.
- Where will it take me? After your Apprenticeship, you can continue your career in marketing. The College offers a number of accredited and non-accredited management and marketing courses to help you progress in your career.

#### TEAM LEADER/ SUPERVISOR LEVEL 3 APPRENTICESHIP

A Team Leader or Supervisor is a front line management role, often with operational or project responsibilities or responsibility for managing a team to deliver a clearly defined outcome.

Team Leaders and Supervisors provide direction, instructions and guidance to ensure the achievement of set goals.

### CARE, COMMUNITY & EDUCATION

## EARLY YEARS PRACTITIONER LEVEL 2 APPRENTICESHIP

Early Years Practitioners are found in a range of private and public settings including; full day care, children's centres, pre-schools, reception classes, playgroups, nursery schools, home based provision, hospitals, social care settings, out of school environments and local authority provision.

- Why choose this course? Starting a career as an Early Years Practitioner Apprentice is perfect for those who wish to work and interact directly with children on a day-to-day basis, supporting the planning of and delivery of activities, purposeful play opportunities and educational programmes within the ethos of the setting. An Early Years Practitioner works as part of a professional team ensuring the welfare and care for children under the guidance and supervision of an Early Years Educator, teacher or other suitably qualified professional in the Early Years Workforce
- Where will it take me? After your Apprenticeship, you can progress onto an Early Years Educator Level 3 Apprenticeship if the necessary requirements are met.

## EARLY YEARS EDUCATOR LEVEL 3 APPRENTICESHIP

The Early Years Educator
Apprenticeship (Level 3) is
for those with an ambition to
work in a childcare setting
e.g. nurseries, pre-schools,
childminders, working on their
own and/or supervising others.
The qualification confirms
competence in this area and
serves as a required qualification
for all new practitioners for
registration and regulatory
requirements in the Early
Learning and Childcare sector.

- Why choose this course? Early Years Educators, and other job roles such as Nursery Nurse and Childminders, are highly trained professionals who play a key role in ensuring that young children learn and develop well and are kept healthy and safe. They work in a range of settings including full day care, children's centres, preschools, reception classes and as childminders. They may either be working on their own or supervising others to deliver the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) requirements set by Government for the learning, development and care of children from birth to 5-years-old, and gain knowledge of working with children from 5 - 7 years.
- Where will it take me? After your Apprenticeship, you can continue in your role as an early years educator or seek further training at university level (4 and 5) with courses such as FdA Childhood Education (3 8 years) or FdA Children and Young People's Workforce (0 19 years).

#### TEACHING ASSISTANT LEVEL 3 APPRENTICESHIP

Teaching Assistants work in Primary, Special and Secondary education across all age ranges encompassing Special Educational Needs (SEN) and emotional vulnerabilities. The primary role of the Teaching Assistant is to support the class teacher to enhance pupils' learning either in groups or individually, ensuring pupils understand the work set, know their learning objectives and stay on task in order to make progress.

- Why choose this course?
  The Apprenticeship is ideal for those who are keen to develop their skills as a Teaching Assistant (TA) and provide the best support for pupils and teachers. The Teaching Assistant Apprenticeship is a new qualification and was written specifically by schools, it is the most current qualification available adapting to the everevolving role of the TA.
- Where will it take me? After your Apprenticeship, you could move onto Higher Level Teaching Assistant or a Foundation Degree in Early Education or Children and Young People's Workforce.

#### **ARCHITECTURAL JOINER LEVEL 2 APPRENTICESHIP**

An Architectural Joiner will normally be employed in a workshop producing timberbased building components and other architectural products such as doors, windows, units and staircases, which are then transported to construction sites to be installed by site carpenters.

#### Why choose this course? An Architectural Joiner will

produce building components by setting out, marking out and manufacturing basic architectural products including doors. windows, straight staircases and associated ironmongery. Joiners also liaise with other workshop colleagues and supervisors as well as architects, designers and customers. As a joiner you will be responsible for working as part of a team and under supervision using machinery and/or tools to create structures or components from designs, plans and specifications that meet the client's expectations. The programme offers great routes into further education or possible direct employment upon completion.

#### Where will it take me? The Level 2 Apprenticeship has been designed to enable students to progress directly into employment in the construction sector as an architectural joiner or advance to further studies at Level 3.

#### **BRICKLAYER LEVEL 2 APPRENTICESHIP**

As an Apprentice, you will carry out tasks relating to the laving of masonry products to meet a desired specification and tolerance. Examples of this include the construction of foundations, partitions, arches and other structures. You will learn to lay blocks and stone using a range of materials while on your programme, which is essential to the local industry here in Cornwall.

#### Why choose this course?

Through this Apprenticeship you will gain a formal qualification while working within the industry. This Apprenticeship will suit individuals who are starting a role within a construction environment, offering a practical approach and a solid platform for anyone wishing to develop in this career path. The construction sector is the driving force behind the UK economy, employing three million people and contributing 6.4% of GDP. A career in the construction industry is like no other, and bricklaving is a core function within the construction sector, particularly the house building sector.

Where will it take me? This qualification has been designed to enable students to progress directly into employment in the construction sector as a bricklayer or onto higher levels of study at Level 3. This course will also suit existing bricklayers or craft masons, assisting them to gain a qualification that will enhance their career prospects or progress onto further study at advanced level.

#### PAINTER & **DECORATOR LEVEL 2 APPRENTICESHIP**

This course is the first step towards a career as a Painter and Decorator. The role of the Painter and Decorator is to prepare and internally/externally paint and decorate buildings and structures to architects' specifications and industrial standards accurately and consistently. They work inside and outside of buildings repairing and preparing surfaces for decoration and redecoration.

#### • Why choose this course?

You will be taught painting and decorating in our first-class workshops, classrooms and IT suites and will continue to repair. prepare, paint and decorate products, components and structures and produce specialist paint finishes on your own and in small teams. Of course, it's not all about practical skills, employers need enthusiastic and engaged employees to meet the demands of the construction industry and to help their business grow. You will therefore need to gain further knowledge of how the construction industry and other trades work together and operate. This will give you the very best opportunity to progress and forge a successful and rewarding career in the construction industry.

#### Where will it take me?

After your Apprenticeship, you can progress onto the Level 3 Apprenticeship or a range of specialist construction or business skills programmes.

#### SITE CARPENTER LEVEL 2 APPRENTICESHIP

The Level 2 Apprenticeship in Site Carpentry involves carrying out skilled work, primarily using timber products on a construction site but also in a workshop, creating and installing building components.

- Why choose this course? Site Carpenters will invariably work on a building site or in domestic and commercial premises preparing and fixing building components from the initial erection of a new building through to the installation of all necessary fixtures and fittings, as well as a range of repair and maintenance activities. The Level 2 Apprenticeship is designed to enable those who are employed as Site Carpenter Apprentices to gain a formal qualification at College while working. This Level 2 Apprenticeship will suit individuals who are starting a role as a Site Carpenter or within a construction environment, offering a practical approach and a solid platform for anyone wishing to develop in this career path. The programme has a great balance of on-site industry experience and taught content at College.
- Where will it take me? The Level 2 Apprenticeship has been designed to enable students to progress directly into employment in the construction sector as a site carpenter or advance to further studies at Level 3.



## PLASTERER LEVEL 2 APPRENTICESHIP

As an Apprentice in Plastering you will carry out tasks relating to solid plastering and rendering on walls and ceilings. Plastering serves a protective function in that it makes buildings more robust and also an aesthetic function. Plasterers will often complete dry lining projects during their career.

- Why choose this course? The plastering Apprenticeship offers an excellent route into employment within the industry and involves applying a range of plastering systems onto different background surfaces using traditional and modern materials. You will learn to prepare background surfaces including solid plain walls, walls with openings and returns, ceiling joists and partitions and beams and piers that are attached or independent of walls. You will also study solid plastering work which includes preparing solid backgrounds by hand and mechanical means and installing sheet materials such as expanded metal lath/rib lath, standard angle beads, skim beads, stop beads, expansion beads and reinforcements for the application of one, two or three coat plastering or rendering systems. As a solid plasterer you would mainly be installing products on site.
- Where will it take me? After your Apprenticeship, you will be able to progress onto a range of specialist construction programmes in your area of interest.

#### ADVANCED ARCHITECTURAL JOINER LEVEL 3 APPRENTICESHIP

This occupation involves carrying out advanced, skilled joinery work primarily using timber products, either on a construction site or in a workshop, creating and installing building components. As an advanced joiner you will be able to undertake complex tasks requiring high levels of practical skills and knowledge, in addition to managing your own work and leading small teams.

- Why choose this course? The Level 3 Apprenticeship prepares you for an occupation that is found in both the new build and refurbishment construction sector. The construction industry is central to creating the homes, schools, hospitals, energy and transport infrastructure society needs. There is growing demand for carpenters and joiners to help meet the need for new homes. The broad purpose of advanced carpentry is working with timber to create and install building components.
- Where will it take me? The Level 3 Apprenticeship has been designed to enable students to progress directly into employment in the construction sector as an architectural joiner. This course will also suit existing bench joiners, assisting them to gain a qualification that will enhance their career prospects or allow them to progress onto further study.

## ADVANCED SITE CARPENTER LEVEL 3 APPRENTICESHIP

This occupation involves carrying out advanced skilled work, primarily using timber products on a construction site, creating and installing building components. The advanced site carpenter undertakes complex job tasks, requiring high levels of practical skills and knowledge, in addition to managing their own work and leading small teams.

- Why choose this course? The Level 3 Apprenticeship is designed to enable those who are employed as Site Carpentry Apprentices to gain a formal qualification at College while working. This Level 3 Apprenticeship will suit individuals who are continuing a role as a site carpenter within a construction environment, offering a practical approach and a solid platform for anyone wishing to develop further in this career path. An advanced site carpenter will normally work on a building site or in domestic and commercial premises, preparing and installing complex and often bespoke building components.
- Where will it take me? After your Apprenticeship, you will be able to progress directly into employment in the construction sector as a site carpenter. This course will also suit existing site carpenters, assisting them to gain a qualification that will enhance their career prospects or enable them to progress onto further study.

#### BEAUTY THERAPIST LEVEL 2 APPRENTICESHIP

This Beauty Therapy
Apprenticeship allows learners
to achieve a Level 2 qualification
while gaining valuable
experience as a therapist. Upon
completion, you will be able to
progress on to an advanced
Level 3 qualification.

- Why choose this course? This qualification includes waxing, make-up, eyelash and eyebrow tinting, evebrow shaping, hand, nail and foot treatments, facial skin care, basic massage, individual evelash application, consultation techniques and client care, health, safety and hygiene, and anatomy and physiology for beauty therapists. On completion, you will be able to perform beauty therapy treatments and implement safe working practices that meet legal, industry and organisational requirements.
- After your Apprenticeship, you can progress towards Level 3 Advanced courses in general or specialised areas such as Level 3 Beauty Therapy General, Level 3 Nail Services and Level 3

## HAIR PROFESSIONAL - BARBERING LEVEL 2 APPRENTICESHIP

Learn and develop industrystandard barbering skills while gaining hands-on experience on this Apprenticeship programme. The completion of this course will create a variety of opportunities, including the chance to progress onto a Level 3 Barbering Qualification.

- Why choose this course? This relatively new style of programme is often selected by Barbers as it aims to focus all training on the commercial service needs. This course is perfect for passionate and driven up-and-coming stylists wanting to embark on their Barbering careers. There will be a balance of taught sessions and industry experience during this course, this will further support and enhance the learning journey. Throughout the qualification, you will develop an understanding of all relevant industry skills as well as developing interpersonal skills to assist you in your effective communication with clients and professionals.
- Where will it take me? After your Apprenticeship, you can continue your career as a barber, or further develop your skills with the Hairdressing Level 3 Apprenticeship.

#### HAIR PROFESSIONAL -HAIRDRESSING

#### LEVEL 2 Apprenticeship

Studying an advanced Level 3 hairdressing qualification will allow you to take your skills into the wider industry by working in a salon alongside your College work, gaining valuable experience and knowledge.

- Why choose this course? This course will allow you to take ownership of your work, client lists and responsibilities within your hair salon. During this qualification vou will learn how to carry out precision and personalised cutting techniques, you will also learn how to use colour to create bespoke looks and strengthening and smoothing techniques. You will learn a variety of fashionforward styling and dressing techniques which will increase your employability skills across a wider range of industry career opportunities.
- Where will it take me? After your Apprenticeship, you could decide to move onto the Hairdressing Level 3 Apprenticeship.

## NAIL SERVICES TECHNICIAN LEVEL 2 APPRENTICESHIP

On this course you will gain the technical and social skills you need for a successful career in the beauty industry. This course will also enable you to progress further on to an Apprenticeship, or to work in the industry as a nail technician.

#### • Why choose this course?

Throughout this qualification. you will develop your knowledge and understanding in a range of skills and techniques, alongside developing interpersonal skills that will assist you to communicate effectively with clients and understand the expectations required when in the industry. This one-year qualification is mainly a practical course, using a variety of teaching methods including discussions, demonstrations, and presentations. You will work on your own, in pairs and in small groups practicing techniques within a realistic working environment in well-equipped, purpose-built salons. The nail qualification includes carrying out a client consultation service, manicure. pedicure, gel polish, nail art, nail enhancements and health and safetv.

 Where will it take me? Following this course, you can either enter the industry as a Nail Technician or continue your studies with the College at Level 3.

## ADVANCED BEAUTY THERAPIST

## LEVEL 3 APPRENTICESHIP

The Apprenticeship will suit an individual who wants to further their career in beauty therapy, learning advanced beauty treatments for the industry. This will enable them to become more employable in this skills sector.

- Why choose this course? The broad purpose of this occupation is to provide, design and implement bespoke treatment plans. These advanced treatments range from advanced manual therapies such as advanced massage techniques, technical therapies such as face and body electrical treatments, to meet and manage client needs and expectations. An employee in this occupation will be responsible for working independently delivering treatments in a private, secure and safe environment. An advanced beauty therapist will also, when required, supervise others to support team and business growth.
- Where will it take me? An advanced beauty therapist can be employed within the beauty industry, travel, leisure and health sectors, in a variety of salons, spas and aesthetic environments.



- Why choose this course? You will learn to complete an in-depth dynamic client profile consultation, manage client records and apply safe and effective methods of working. You will perform and adapt advanced manual therapy techniques to meet client's physical and psychological characteristics, treatment objectives, needs and expectations and perform wellness and holistic therapy treatments, adapting these according to client needs. Additionally, you will learn how to complete an in-depth client lifestyle profile, body and skin analysis, learn strategies to aid relaxation and manage stress levels and learn how to select the most suitable wellbeing and holistic principle to apply.
- Where will it take me? Successful completion of this Apprenticeship could lead to employment in wellbeing environments such as Spas, Leisure, Holistic or Wellness Therapy centres, Medi-spas and Beauty salons.

There are multiple, well-equipped performance spaces for you to explore your talents. The fully equipped music recording studios are used for teaching and you can book them for your use.

You can use our theatre and studio spaces, inside and out, for drama performances. Due to our excellent facilities, there is a varied programme of performances, workshops and external classes across the College as a whole, which you will be able to access.

We have excellent sports facilities that you can access during the day. There is an indoor multi-use games area for a range of sports and a fully equipped fitness suite for strength, conditioning and aerobic activity.

There is also a third generation floodlit Astro turf pitch, providing such a high standard facility that it is used by the Cornish Pirates for training. Penzance Leisure Centre, including a swimming pool, is situated over the road from the College.

Hair and beauty students learn in our Inspiration salons, where you can enjoy a discounted hair cut or treatment. If you are looking to unwind from your studies with a relaxing massage, getting a quick trim before heading out with your friends or a quick splash of colour with a manicure, you can get it all right here at the College.

Through our Learning Centres, you will have access to a comprehensive range of contemporary books, journals, audiovisual and online materials that will provide inspiration for studying and to help improve your results.

Learning and leisure are blended successfully. There are cafés and social spaces across the campus to enable you to enjoy your time outside of taught classes, and of course, the breathtaking view across Mount's Bay and St Michael's Mount.

#### **ACCESS**

The buildings at Penwith College are almost unique amongst colleges because the facilities are accessible to all students. All parts of the College may be accessed by people with limited mobility and within the College there are a number of lifts designated for their use.

#### REFRESHMENTS

Penwith College has several refectories across the campus. A wide variety of reasonably priced meals, sandwiches, drinks and snacks are all available on site. Details of opening times will be published in the Student Diary, available at the start of the academic year. The College operates a cashless catering system or students can use a debit/credit card.

#### LEARNING CENTRES/ LIBRARIES

You will find textbooks necessary for your course, plus access to other physical resources such as books, journals and DVDs. We also have an Online Learning Centre where you will find access to our online resources such as eBooks, eJournals and suitable websites, most of which can be accessed both on and off campus.

We have lots of resources which will support your studying and if you need help locating a resource or using the facilities in the Learning Centres & Libraries you can speak to one of the experienced team who are there to assist you.

All of our resources are free to borrow, we just ask that they are returned in good condition to the Library by their due date and request that students pay a College deposit to enable the use of College resources. This is refunded at the end of your course when all College resources are returned. The Learning Centres and Libraries also provide quiet places for studying and have study tables and open access computers which offer a wide range of software to assist you.

#### INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

The College has a large number of computers capable of using an extensive range of software available for students to use on a drop-in basis. Students are expected to improve their awareness of, and skills in, information technology (IT).

There are many IT workshops with staff who can support you in your use of IT. The College has Wi-Fi throughout the buildings, which enables students to access the internet and complete College work using their own devices.

#### **COLLEGE SHOP**

Almost all of the materials needed for your course should be available through the shop. Prices are very competitive compared to retail outlets. Products available include photographic, electronic and computer consumables. It also has a wide range of art and stationery materials. All money for trips and visits are collected here.

#### SUPPORT SERVICES

#### GCSES & FUNCTIONAL SKILLS

Any student who is yet to achieve a Grade 4 in maths and/or English (either Language or Literature) will be required to retake these qualifications. For those students who achieve a Grade 3, this will be GCSE. For those who achieve a Grade 2 or below this will be either GCSE or Functional Skills and will be determined by previous qualifications and an initial assessment. For students who have already achieved a Grade 4, there are opportunities available to improve to a higher grade. Students can access this type of programme by speaking with their Programme Team Leader (PTL). In many cases, progression opportunities will be dependent on achievement of English and maths.

#### LEARNING SUPPORT

Many students discover during their course that they require some additional help with an aspect of their studies. The College will always endeavour to meet your needs and in the Study Centre in the Lamorna Building you will find staff who can help with literacy, numeracy and general study skills.

#### **TUTOR SUPPORT**

At Penwith College, you will get to know many members of staff and other students easily. You will be assigned a tutor who will usually be one of the people who teach you. Your tutor will get to know you well and will usually be the first person you go to if you need advice or help.

You will also join a tutor group of students for which a senior member of staff will be responsible.

#### **CAREERS GUIDANCE**

The College has received the Investor in Careers Award in recognition of the comprehensive service that is provided and has fully met the Gatsby benchmarks for careers guidance. We have a commitment to offer impartial. supportive, timely and informal careers guidance to all students. Students have entitlement to careers education and guidance from tutors and course lecturers. PTLs and the careers adviser. We conduct individual careers interviews with students and offer workshops to tutor groups.

Students have the opportunity to discuss their personal progression routes and receive support in making decisions appropriate to their needs.

You will find a range of careers literature and software available in Student Services and resources areas around the College. College careers staff are highly-qualified, receive regular training and participate in many initiatives in this fast-changing field.

#### STUDENT SERVICES

If you are in need of advice, guidance and support, the Student Services team is dedicated to helping you. We want you to successfully complete your course and our professional team of staff will work with you to support you in progressing into your future career or into higher education.

#### STUDENT SUPPORT

Support given is wide-ranging and any problems experienced by students during their course, either personal or academic, will be addressed as quickly as possible.

Where the sharing of personal information with appropriate agencies is necessary for the vital interests of a student or other person (for safeguarding or life preserving measures), we will do this in accordance with our duties under the General Data Protection Regulation or other current legislation.

Sometimes, we may need to share information and work in partnership with other agencies when there are concerns about a child's, young person's or vulnerable adult's welfare. We will ensure that our concerns about our children, young people and vulnerable adults are discussed with their parents/carers first (as appropriate) unless we have reason to believe that such a move would be contrary to the child's, young person's or vulnerable adult's welfare.

#### COLLEGE POLICIES & PROCEDURES

#### STUDENT LIFE

Penwith College has very few rules, but both you as a student and all College staff work within the Charter to ensure everyone has the most positive and beneficial experience possible.

Before you become a student at Penwith College, we aim to provide you with information about the courses we offer and the practicalities of being a student here. We will let you know about transport, finance, equipment and progression. If you have any additional needs, we will give you details of the individually tailored support you can expect at Penwith College.

Once you apply, you can expect us to process your application fairly and efficiently and, normally within three weeks of receipt of your application form, provide you with a date and time for an interview. The interview is a good opportunity for both you and the College to ensure you are choosing a course that is right for you and that you have all the information you need.

After your interview, a decision about a place at Penwith College can usually be made.

When you start as a Penwith College student, we will give you a thorough induction. You will receive a lot of new information including details on learning resources, dates, security, health and safety, safeguarding, attendance, assignments and College rules, procedures and policies. You will also be provided with this information by email, which will give you a record of all the information for you to refer back to.

As a student at Penwith College. you will accept more responsibility for your work and your progress than during your time at school. Many courses require you to work extensively on your own in College and at home. First class study facilities are available in the College and successful students use these effectively. We will help you to organise your work, but you will be responsible for ensuring that you meet deadlines. The College requires that you attend regularly and punctually and that you meet the demands of your course. We hope that you will enjoy your time at Penwith College and the staff at the College will work with you to help you achieve success.

#### **COLLEGE DAY**

The College day for full-time students will usually last from 9.15am to 4.15pm. Students will have some private study time within the College day.

#### THE TRURO & PENWITH COLLEGE CHARTER

Just as we expect our students to aim at achieving a high standard, so should students have expectations that the College will deliver high quality learning programmes and services. The College Charter, available from reception and online, sets out in more detail the standards we will achieve.

## DRUGS, ALCOHOL AND SMOKING POLICY

This College does not condone the use of drugs or alcohol. We seek to educate students about drug and alcohol-related issues and provide help to those who ask for it. All Truro and Penwith College sites have a smoke free policy.

### DATA PROTECTION ACT

Any information that you provide during the application process is protected under the 1984 Data Protection Act.

### **FEES**

If you are aged 16 to 18 years and a student under the age of 19 on 31 August, you will not normally be charged fees for tuition. Overseas students or mature students will be liable for fees and details will be available from the College.

### **EXAMINATION FEES**

Full-time students who do not pay tuition fees would not normally be asked to pay for examinations that are taken as part of the course with the College's approval. Students who pay tuition fees will need to pay their own examination fees.

### **FEES WAIVER**

Students who are in receipt of an income-related, tested state benefit may be eligible for a fee waiver in some circumstances. If you are concerned because you have to pay tuition fees, then please contact Student Services on 01736 809000.



# FAQ YOUR QUESTIONS ANSWERED

- My school has a sixth form, do I have to stay there? Although you now have to stay in full-time education until the end of the academic year in which you turn 18, it's your choice where you want to study.
- Why should I choose Penwith College? There are many reasons why Penwith College is a great place to study after you have finished school. See the 'Why Choose Us?' section of this prospectus for information.
- Can I have a look around the College? Penwith College run a number of Open Events throughout the year. Whether online or in person, you can hear from staff, view the fantastic facilities and find out about your life as a student. See inside the back page for full details.
- Can I just enrol in an academy?

  No. Academies are offered only in conjunction with a full-time programme of study. They are intended as a supplement for, and not an alternative to, the qualifications the College runs.

- Do courses have entry requirements? Yes, most courses do, though we do offer courses for those with no prior qualifications and we always treat everyone as an individual. Please refer to the 'Options Explained' section for details of what grades you need to start your chosen course.
- I can't decide what type of course to take; what might help me choose? The 'What to Choose' section in this prospectus gives details about the types of courses we offer and what they entail. There is a huge choice at Penwith College, from A Levels to vocational courses and Apprenticeships, so there is bound to be something to suit you here. Attending an Open Event is highly recommended to help you make this decision.
- Can I go to university if I don't take A Levels? Vocational courses also provide a proven route to university providing the subjects are compatible. College Open Events are a great opportunity for you to find out whether the course you want to follow is suitable for applying to university, as is your interview.
- How do I apply for a course? The applications process is covered fully in the 'How to Apply' section of this prospectus. Firstly, complete an application. This can be done online at truro-penwith. ac.uk
- When can I apply and when will my interview take place? You can send in your application whenever you like, usually from January onwards. Interviews take place at different times for everyone; this is because each application is looked at and assessed individually. Don't panic if your friend has an interview date sent to them before you doyou haven't been forgotten!

- What questions will I be asked at my interview? Your interview is not a pass/fail test. It is a consultation where you discuss your plans for your future both in and beyond education. Your course choices are looked at relative to your own aspirations, to ensure that the two things match up reasonably well. Parents or carers can attend their child's interview if they wish. At the interview, once a suitable course has been agreed, you will be sent an offer email. You need to fill this out and return it to us as soon as possible.
- What if I don't get the GCSE grades I was expecting? Firstly, don't panic! There's a course for everyone available at the College not attaining your expected GCSE grades does not mean your offer to study here has been withdrawn. You will be asked to attend an advice session, to discuss whether pursuing your selected course is the right choice for you, or if another course might suit you better in light of your recent results.
- How will I get to College?

The College has excellent public transport links via bus. Subsidised travel is available to full-time students under the age of 19 who live further than three miles from the College. Please see the 'Your Journey to College' section for more details.

### What is Enrichment?

Enrichment is an opportunity to further your current interests, or develop new ones. Courses on offer can assist you in gaining further qualifications such as the Duke of Edinburgh Award, or they can simply be a way for you to enjoy your hobbies. Further information can be found in 'The Low-down' section.





For the vast majority of students, travelling to College by bus is a great option. Public transport is an environmentally friendly and reliable way to get here. We understand that you may be anxious about travel, after all this might be a big change from your normal school journey, but rest assured that the bus service will get you to your lectures on time. Many of you will travel from all over Cornwall and so some journeys will take longer than you are used to. That's ok, you can use this time to study, relax and make friends. Wherever you are travelling from, your journey to Penwith College is the road to an inspiring future.

### **BUS PASSES**

Truro and Penwith College students travel on an enhanced public bus service that includes more services and more direct routes straight to our campuses making it easier for students to arrive at College later or leave earlier if their timetable allows. All transport to College bus passes are purchased via the First Bus Travel App and honoured by First Bus & Transport for Cornwall, so can be used on all services regardless of the operator. These include Go Cornwall Bus, Cornwall by Kernow (First), OTS and Hopleys.

### **OUR NEW 16-18 TRAVEL BURSARY**

We understand that the costs of travel are high but the College can help most students with the costs of bus passes through our travel bursary. Any learner eligible for financial support through the travel bursary will be issued with a First Kernow bus pass which will be honoured by Transport for Cornwall, so can be used on all services regardless of operator. Your bursary application will be based on information provided, together with evidence of household income which should accompany your application.

Choosing to travel on foot or by bicycle reduces air pollution and traffic congestion, while saving you money and keeping you fit. Using public transport also helps reduce your carbon footprint, so check out your travel options below and play your part in making Penzance a better place to study.

### Walking to College

Walking is a simple way to fit physical activity into your day, it's cheap and helps keep you fit. Why not transform your trip to the gym into your commute to College? There are numerous quieter walking opportunities from the centre of Penzance to the College, which take approximately 15 minutes along residential streets.

There is an underpass linking Heamoor, to the north, with the College to avoid crossing the A30 trunk road.

### Cycling to College

Cycling is a great option for travelling to College, especially if you live within five miles, where journeys by bike can take less than 25 minutes. There are so many benefits to travelling by bike - it's good for our health, the environment and saves money at the same time.

With the right clothing and equipment, weather and luggage need not be a barrier to travelling to College on two wheels. There is ample covered cycle storage around the campus and showers/changing facilities are available (shown on the cycle facilities map available on the College website).

Penzance is only a short 10 minute cycle ride away and it is possible to access the campus via quieter residential streets. For cycle routes try: cyclestreets.net

### **Walking and Cycling Routes**

There are traffic-free routes from Marazion and Newlyn into College, which form part of the National Cycle Network. For further information on routes in the area, visit Sustrans mapping at sustrans. org.uk/national-cycle-network.

#### **Trains**

Frequent mainline trains serve Penzance station and regular buses connect to the College. Alternatively, Adelaide Street and Taroveor Road provide a walking route along quieter streets, from the station to the College. This takes approximately 15 minutes to walk. Why not opt for a multimodal option? Bicycles can be transported by train - you'll need to make a booking for your bike if it's a high-speed train, non-bookable bike spaces are available on local trains.

### **Driving to College**

Truro and Penwith College promotes the use of sustainable travel as the first option to get to your place of study. However, we recognise the fact that sometimes car travel is unavoidable. Carshare Cornwall provides a free service for passengers and drivers to link up and share car journeys. Click on the cost calculator on carsharecornwall.com to work out how much you could save.

## FOUNDATION ART & DESIGN

The Foundation Diploma in Art and Design is an opportunity for individuals to develop their creative skills, explore a wide range of disciplines, learn new techniques and challenge their imagination. This course provides a year of practical study, enabling learners to make informed decisions about potential future prospects as an artist or designer, as well as possible applications to degree courses.

The course explores a broad range of creative ideas, starting with a series of workshops that include graphic design, illustration, painting, 3D, sculpture, photography, printmaking and textiles. As the year progresses, students will specialise in the area of their choice.

### **Entry Requirements**

Students will normally be 18 years old when starting this course, having achieved A Level qualifications or an Extended Diploma within art-based subjects.

Mature students with or without formal qualifications are welcomed. All applicants are interviewed with a supporting portfolio of creative work.

In preparation for higher education, students complete core units, such as study skills, as well as subjects relating to their chosen pathway.

Access to Higher Education courses are designed to give students the necessary grounding to succeed in higher education. The majority of British universities will accept Access to Higher Education courses as an alternative to A Levels and other more traditional routes. Students are usually aged 19 or over at the beginning of the course and all applicants will be expected to attend an interview. Courses normally start mid-September and finish at the end of May. Taught hours will be approximately 15 hours per week depending on the pathway chosen. Courses usually run over three days per week (9.15am to 4.15pm) to offer flexibility.






