



Higher Education Students Bursary 2023/24

All Students who pay the full tuition fees will be eligible for a college bursary.

In 2023/24 the bursary will be paid in 3 instalments –

Instalment 1 – Thursday 07 December 2023

Instalment 2 – Thursday 29 February 2024

Instalment 3 – Thursday 23 May 2024

Bursary Forms must be received by Friday 10th November to receive the December payment. Bursary Forms received after this date will be paid on the next available instalment date.

The bursary will be paid providing we have received your tuition fees¹ from either yourself or Student Finance and that you are actively registered² at the time of payment. If your course requires you to have a DBS check this must also have been completed.

¹If you are late in paying your tuition fee loan this may delay the bursary payment.

²Actively Registered means regularly attending college and presenting work.
