

PAYMENT OF TUITION FEES 2024-2025

TUITION FEE LOAN (Eligible Students)

Please note that you are personally liable for your fees unless we receive full payment from Student Finance. Please ensure that you apply immediately, if you have not already done so.

It is possible to apply to Student Finance England (or the appropriate authority for Welsh, Scottish or Northern Ireland Students) for a loan to cover the cost of the tuition fees.

If you choose to borrow the course fee, the monies will then be paid direct to the college.

PAYING OWN FEES

If it is your intention to pay your fees yourself then please confirm with the Finance Office how you will be paying, either on registration day or before start of term.

Instalments

Late Payment

If payment has not been made or if the College has not received notification that a loan has been awarded by the Student Loans Company by 11th November 2024, you may be liable to a late payment penalty of £50.

DEBT FROM A PREVIOUS YEAR

Any student who owes money from a previous year will not be allowed to re-register and take up their place on their course unless satisfactory arrangements have been made to repay the outstanding balance with the Finance Office (Please call me on 01872 305101 to discuss this).

STUDENT LOAN

Please bring in your University / College Payment Advice on Registration Day. This will be required to authorise the Student Loan Company to make your first loan payment and will then be kept to ensure that you receive the correct amount of bursary.
