In addition to our comprehensive Enrichment programme, we support those who are academically talented, preparing them for application to the most competitive Universities and successful careers in the field of their choice.

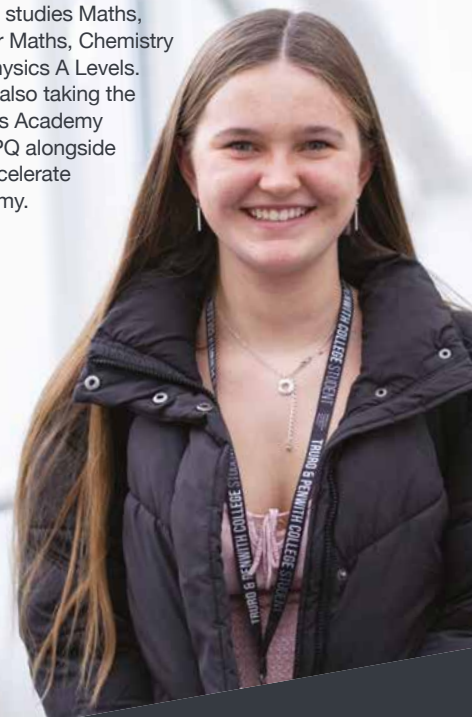

IB DIPLOMA

This two-year, Level 3 course is an excellent alternative to A Levels and provides a broad-based education. The IB is widely accepted by universities.

What do you need? Five GCSEs at Grade 4 or above in a broad range of subjects, including English and Maths at Grade 5. Grade 6 is required in subjects appropriate to Higher Level options.

T LEVELS

This qualification combines classroom theory and practical learning with an extended industry placement of 45 days. A T Level is a full-time two-year course equivalent to three A Levels. Find out more at truro-penwith.ac.uk/t-levels

What do you need? Entry requirements for T level vary depending on the subject, but most require 4 GCSEs at Grades 4/5 or above, plus English Language and Maths. A Level 2 Diploma at Merit in an appropriate subject can also be considered (plus English and/or Maths).
