



Higher Education Students Bursary 2025-2026

All Students who pay the full tuition fees will be eligible for a college bursary.

In 2025-2026 the bursary will be paid in 3 instalments.

Instalment 1 – Thursday 11th December 2025

Instalment 2 – Thursday 26th February 2026

Instalment 3 – Thursday 21st May 2026

Bursary Forms must be received by Friday 7th November 2025 to receive the **December payment.** Bursary Forms received after this date will be paid on the next available instalment date.

The bursary will be paid providing we have received your tuition fees¹ from either yourself or Student Finance and that you are actively registered² at the time of payment. If your course requires you to have a DBS check this must also have been completed.

¹If you are late in paying your tuition fee loan this may delay the bursary payment. ²Actively Registered means regularly attending college and presenting work.
