WHERE WILL IT TAKE ME?

Successful completers of the Level 2 Certificate in Music, coupled with a GCSE Grade 4 or above in Maths or English, most often progress onto one of our Level 3 Extended Diploma courses in Music Performance, Music Technology or Live Events Production. These courses lead onto a range of careers within the industry. Some career pathways include jobs as Session Musicians, Music Promoters and Events managers, Producers and Engineers, Film Composers, Record Label roles including A&R and Management, Journalists and Product Designers.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Three GCSEs at Grade 3 including English Language (or English Literature) and/or Maths. Though no formal music education is required, you should be able to display an enthusiasm and passion for the subject and have some previous experience in performance or production.
