Four GCSEs at Grade 4 or above or a Level 2 Diploma in appropriate subjects (to include English Language or Literature and/or Mathematics at Grade 4 or above). Though no formal music education is required, you should be able to display not only an enthusiasm and passion for the subject, but also an aptitude for performance and experience of an instrument or voice. You will be expected to attend an interview and audition, at which you will play or sing two contrasting pieces to assess your suitability for the course.
