ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

All applicants **must have** a Level 2 or equivalent in Maths and English. Good information and communications technology (ICT) skills. Level 3 or above in subject specialism for Cert.Ed. applicants Applicants with overseas qualifications can check their compatibility with the UK equivalent through UK ECCTIS, who provide an advisory service. We welcome applicants with international qualifications. To view other accepted qualifications please refer to our tariff glossary. If English is not your first language then we'll need evidence of your proficiency in English with IELTS 7.0 overall with 7.0 in all four elements, or accepted equivalent English qualification as listed on our English language requirements. **Non-academic requirements** Entry onto these programmes is conditional on identifying a suitable placement and mentor. An interview is a prerequisite for entry onto this programme. Applicants' subject knowledge should be current and continuing professional development is expected. Applicants will need to commit wholeheartedly to the course and will be expected to complete academic coursework in addition to a full teaching practice which includes planning, delivery assessment and evaluation. The College expects quality teaching and the chance to work at Truro and Penwith College is exceptional. You'll be required to complete a satisfactory enhanced DBS (formerly CRB) Enhanced Disclosure, register with the Independent Safeguarding Authority and complete a criminal convictions self-declaration form. Find all of the important documentation you'll need when applying for this programme. All appropriately qualified candidates will be given equal consideration during the selection process.
