WHERE WILL IT TAKE ME?

Upon successful completion of this course, you will be able to progress onto a level 3 Diploma in either Site Carpentry, which requires a further year of study. Alternatively, you could progress onto an Apprenticeship in Carpentry and Joinery working with a local employer and earning while you learn. There are many opportunities for skilled Carpenters and Joiners in the building industry, working for large and small companies or in self-employment. Further study will enable you to work towards more senior roles within the construction industry such as a Working Foreperson, Assistant Site Manager, Site Manager, Quantity Surveyor, Architect, Clerk of Works, Building Surveyor.
