By attending the course learners will:

- Develop an understanding of communication and the important role it plays
- Gain an internationally recognised qualification that is valued by employers

Course content:

- Identify and resolve team performance issues
- Motivate your team to achieve organisational objectives by providing effective recognition and constructive feedback.
- Identify effective team behaviours and methods to develop these in your team
- Understanding the importance of maintaining a healthy and safe work environment
- Developing a knowledge of relevant legislation and the risk assessment process in order to reduce risks in the workplace and maintain a productive environment

To gain the award, learners need to complete three work-based assignments. This course requires self-study outside of the scheduled sessions.
