WHAT WILL I LEARN?

The course will provide you with an introduction to a broad range of creative and technical skills in media production and photography. The qualification has been designed to provide you with a sound base of skills, knowledge and understanding which will enhance your self-confidence and impart an understanding of the career demands and opportunities within the exciting and dynamic creative media industries. During the course you will learn digital photographic techniques in addition to video production and editing skills. Emphasis is placed on the development of your own practice and aspirations.
