



Higher Education Students Bursary 2020/21

All Students who pay the full tuition fees will be eligible for a college bursary.

In 2020/21 the bursary will be paid in 2 instalments –

Instalment 1 – Thursday 25th February 2021

Instalment 2 – Thursday 27th May 2021

The bursary will be paid providing you have paid your tuition fees and/or have taken out a tuition fee loan¹ and are actively registered² at the time of payment. *If your course requires you to have a DBS check this must also have been completed.*
