

PAYMENT OF TUITION FEES – 2020/21

TUITION FEE LOAN (Eligible Students)

Please note that you are personally liable for your fees, unless we receive full payment from Student Finance.

It is possible to apply to Student Finance England (or the appropriate authority for Welsh, Scottish or Northern Ireland Students) for a loan to cover the cost of the tuition fees.

Please ensure that you apply immediately, if you have not already done so.

If you choose to borrow the course fee, the monies will then be paid direct to the college.

PAYING OWN FEES

If it is your intention to pay your fees yourself then payment is due on the 21st September 2020 and can be made either by post to the Finance Office, Truro College, College Road, TRURO TR1 3XX or in person on registration day.

Cash

Please bring in the total amount owing, you can pay this in on Registration Day or to the Finance Office Allen Building Room A101 **Do not send cash through the post.**

Cheque (Please make payable to Truro and Penwith College)

Instalments

Fees can be paid in three instalments. **Instalments are only available by enclosing three post-dated cheques with the Method of Payment form.**

Late Payment

If payment has not been made or if the College has not received notification that a loan has been awarded by the Student Loans Company by 20th November 2020, you will be liable to a late payment penalty of £50.

DEBT FROM A PREVIOUS YEAR

Any student who owes money from a previous year will not be allowed to re-register and take up their place on their course, unless satisfactory arrangements have been made to repay the outstanding balance with the Finance Office (Please call me on 01872 267069 to discuss this).

STUDENT LOAN

Please bring in your University or College Payment Advice on registration day. This will be required to authorise the Student Loan Company to make your first loan payment, and will then be kept to ensure that you receive the correct amount of bursary.
